1. REDUCE COMMUNICATIONS LATENCY



25% of employees in knowledge worker-centric businesses are out of the office on any given day



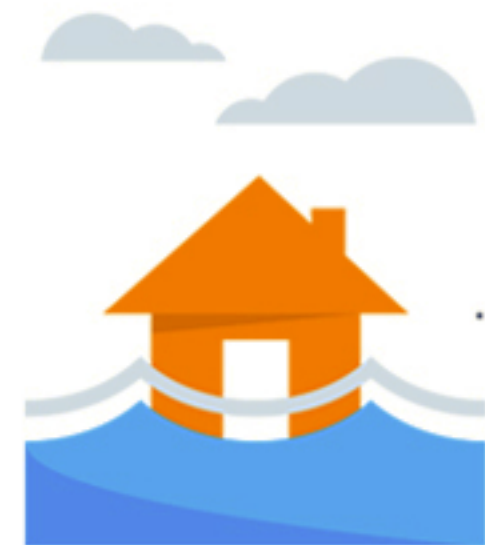
16% are delayed because the team cannot reach a decision maker

2. ENSURE BUSINESS CONTINUITY



75% of remote workers could continue working in the event of a disaster

Only 28% of non-remote workers could continue working



73% of senior executives see their mobile devices as critical to business communications

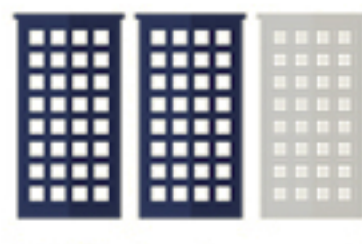
3. SAVE ON HARDWARE WITH BYOD



50% of companies will require employees to supply their own devices for work purposes by 2017

4. IMPROVE PRODUCTIVITY

Businesses lose **\$600 billion** per year to workplace distractions



But 2/3 of employers report increased productivity among their remote workers



Several Fortune 500 companies have found their remote workers to be 35-45% more productive than in-office workers

5. REDUCE EXPENSIVE ATTRITION



Losing a valued employee costs an employer

\$10,000-30,000



14% of Americans have changed jobs to shorten their commutes



95% of employers say remote working has a high impact on employee retention



2/3 of employees would take another job to ease their commutes

6. SAVE ON EMPLOYEE COMPENSATION



36% of employees would choose remote working over a pay raise



37% of technology workers would take a 10% pay cut if they could work from home



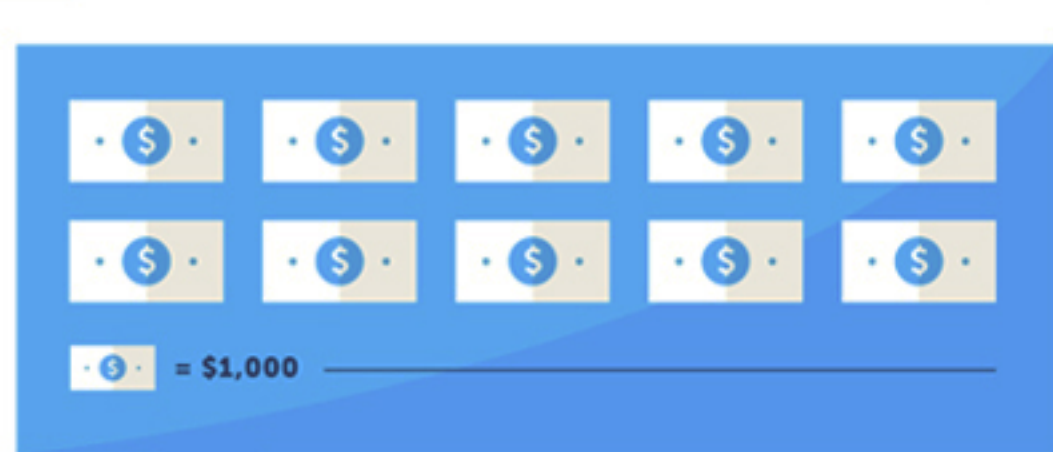
4 out of 5 (80%) of employees consider remote working a job perk, which can be offered in lieu of higher pay or more expensive perks



70% of mobile professionals will conduct work on personal mobile devices by 2018

Office-bound workers, on the other hand, will require expensive company computers

7. SAVE ON REAL ESTATE COSTS



Employers save an average of **\$10,000** per employee per year in real estate costs for full time remote workers



\$50 million real estate savings of a Fortune 500 consulting company that went mobile



\$68 million real estate savings of a major technology company

8. REDUCE UNSCHEDULED ABSENCES

\$300 billion cost of unscheduled absences in the U.S. alone



Organizations that implemented a remote working program saw a 63% reduction in unscheduled absences



- 78% of employees who call in sick really aren't sick
- Remote workers typically continue to work when they're sick (without infecting others)
- Remote workers return to work more quickly following surgery or medical issues



Flexible hours allow remote workers to run errands or schedule appointments without losing a full day
